



Describe Image

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A key scoring area for the PTE [Describe Image](#) task is pronunciation, and the objective is to be easily understood by regular English speakers. During the PTE Describe Image task, word stressing is of the utmost importance. This does not mean stressing the words in a sentence, but rather to emphasize the syllables in a word. If you do not know about syllables, a word can have multiple syllables (and have one vowel sound). It is called Oral Fluency and marks are awarded based on how fluently you speak. Oral fluency is measured in three areas: Sentence stress, Pace and Pausing, and Voice modulation.

It is important to emphasize the meaningful words in a sentence, not the grammatical words, which is called sentence stress. If you struggle to form a meaningful sentence, use the PTE Describe image template. In order for PTE Describe image template to work, it is very important for you to control your pace. Many students try to talk fast in order to cover more points. If you are speaking in a foreign language, you should always speak at a moderate pace, neither too fast nor too slow. When describing an image, you should also be careful about pausing, which is important according to PTE algorithms.
