PTE Exam Format

Here is a brief summary of what has changed in the PTE Listening section, as per the PTE exam format 2022. First, there are no changes in fill in the blanks, highlight incorrect words, and write from dictation in this listening section. However, highlight correct summary, multiple choice, correct answer, and select missing word has been reduced from 3 to 2. A 10-minute optional break was previously part of the PTE exam format. As of November 16, 2021, the optional break has been removed from the new PTE exam format. The removal of the optional break allowed PTE test-takers to complete the test in two hours instead of three hours.

The PTE score report has changed since November 16, 2021. The overall score, reading, writing, and speaking skills scores will remain the same; however, you will no longer earn enabling skill ratings for grammar and vocabulary, instead, you'll receive a report on how to improve them. Here's what you need to know about the changes to the PTE exam. Of all these, it's important to note that the changes will take effect after November 16, 2021.
